





Potholder in leather



The products you need:

- Thick leather
- Grommets
- Leather lace
- Hammer
- Scissors
- Sewing machine
- Pencil
- Wooden beads

<p>Step 1</p> <p>Draw around your hand with a 3-centimetre distance from your hand.</p>	 A close-up photograph showing a person's hand tracing a pattern onto a piece of brown leather. <p>Step 2</p> <p>Cut out the leather following along the lines, you just made.
