
Paper towel holder with leather strap



The products you need:

- Leather strap, 30 mm wide
- Wooden plate, 150 mm
- Sam Browne Button
- Nail
- Glue
- Punch tong
- Hammer
- Ruler
- Drilling machine
- Round stick
- Drill
- Saw
- Sandpaper

| Step 1 | |

| Drill a hole in the wooden plate. | |
| Step 2 | |
| Use a saw to cut the round stick into the desired length. Cut off the end at an angle. | |
| Step 3 Hammer two nails into the leather piece and the wooden plate. | |
| Step 4 Apply glue to the hole and the stick and leave it to get slightly tacky. | |



Step 10

Punch two holes with your rotary leather punch, so that it gets possible to tighten in the leather strap, once the paper towel gets smaller.
